



## Clinic Counselor Trainee – Carpinteria, Santa Barbara, Lompoc, and Santa Maria

### The Position:

Family Service Agency's Traineeship positions are responsible for managing a clinical caseload and contributing to the overall functioning of the clinic. We are looking to fill positions in Carpinteria, Santa Barbara, Lompoc, and Santa Maria. Clinical supervision is provided.

### Sample of Duties and Responsibilities:

- Provide ongoing counseling to individuals, children, families, seniors, couples and/or groups as assigned, under the supervision of a licensed therapist.
- Formulate psychosocial diagnoses, develop clinical goals and treatment plans, perform clinically appropriate advocacy activities, and initiate clinically-indicated interventions.
- Maintain records according to agency policies, including but not limited to completing progress notes within 48 business hours, administrative paperwork, and other related clinical documentation duties in a timely manner
- Provide statistical information as needed.
- Maintain regular communication with the agency (including, but not limited to: weekly clinical supervision, daily checking of agency email and responding as needed, and as-needed individual supervision meetings).
- Participate in outreach opportunities.

### Employment Standards:

- Bachelor degree required.
- Current enrollment in master's or doctoral-level clinical program at an accredited university. Experience in counseling children and families preferred.
- Must possess valid CA Driver License and auto insurance.
- Excellent analytical, computer, written and verbal communication skills
- Professional attitude, teamwork, and ability to maintain confidentiality a must.
- Bilingual (English/Spanish) preferred

### Classification, Hours and Pay Rate:

- This position is a 10-hour per week unpaid internship. Stipend available beginning July 1, 2019.
